BY-LAW NO. 4869

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SELKIRK AUTHORIZING AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAW NO. 4558.

WHEREAS By-Law No. 4558 authorizes regulating firearms and other weapons;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act provides that Council of the Town of Selkirk may pass by-laws for regulating the firing of firearms and the use of other weapons within the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to amend By-Law No. 4558;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Selkirk, in a meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Article 2 of By-Law No. 4558 be amended to read as follows:

"No person shall fire or otherwise discharge or use any firearm within the limits of the Town of Selkirk except in a designated location within the Town of Selkirk as approved by the Attorney Generals' Department and the Town of Selkirk."

2. That Article 5 of By-Law No. 4558 be amended to read as follows:

"Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Officer in Charge of the R.C.M.P. for the Town of Selkirk may authorize the use of a particular firearm for special events, such as but not limited to turkey shoots, sharp shooting and competitions, in such a place as may be specifically designated by him for that purpose."

TOWN OF SELKIRK

BY-LAW NO. 4558

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SELKIRK REGULATING FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS.

WHEREAS THE Municipal Act provides that Council of the Town of Selkirk may pass By-Laws for regulating the firing of firearms and the use of other weapons within the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to pass a by-law preventing the firing of firearms and the use of other weapons within the Town of Selkirk;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Selkirk, in session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. For the purposes of this By-Law “firearm” means any barreled weapon from which any shot, bullet or any other missile can be discharged and includes any frame or receiver of such barreled weapons which can be adapted for use as a firearm as well as any catapult, sling and bow and arrow.
2. No person shall fire or otherwise discharge or use any firearm within the limits of the Town of Selkirk.
3. Every person who fires or otherwise discharges any firearm contrary to the provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offence under this By-Law.
4. The provisions of this by-Law do not apply to authorized personnel in the performance of their duties.
5. Notwithstanding the foregoing the Office in charge of the RCMP for the Town of Selkirk may authorize the use of a particular firearm in such place as may be specifically designated by him for that purpose.
6. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction for a fine not exceeding \$1, 000.00 and in default of payment thereof, and costs, to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 30 days.
7. Anyone convicted of an offence pursuant to the provisions of this By-Law shall, in addition to those penalties set out above, be liable to have the weapon involved in the offence confiscated by the RCMP and disposed of.
