

# Manitoba Paint and HHW Accepted and Not Accepted Products

## Fluorescent Lights

- ✓ 8 foot Fluorescent Bulbs
- ✓ 4 foot Fluorescent Bulbs
- ✓ O,U,D, Shaped Fluorescent Bulbs
- ✓ Compact Fluorescent Bulbs

## Physically Hazardous (non-refillable fuel gas cylinders)

Products that display both the flammable symbol and explosive symbol. Container must be non-refillable and a maximum size of 5kg.

- ✓ Single Use Fuel cylinders
- ✓ Single Use Camping cylinders
- ✓ Single Use Butane cylinders

## Pesticide Products

Consumer pesticides that have the poison (skull & cross bones) symbol, Pest Control Product (PCP) number and the word "Domestic" on the label.

Maximum container size is 10 liters and 680 grams or 24 ounces for aerosols.

- ✓ Liquid pesticides
- ✓ Powdered pesticides
- ✓ Solid pesticides
- ✓ Aerosol pesticide container

## Paint Products

### Paint Products Accepted

Maximum container size is 25 litres for paint and 680 grams or 24 ounces for paint aerosols.

- ✓ Interior and exterior water-based (e.g. latex, acrylic) and oil-based ( e.g. alkyd, enamel) architectural paint
- ✓ Deck, porch and floor coating (including elastomeric)
- ✓ Varnish and urethane (single-component)
- ✓ Concrete and masonry paint
- ✓ Drywall paint
- ✓ Undercoats and primers (e.g. metal, wood, etc.)
- ✓ Stucco paint
- ✓ Marine paint\*
- ✓ Wood preservatives\*
- ✓ Wood finishing oil
- ✓ Melamine, metal and anti-rust paint, stain, and shellac
- ✓ Swimming pool paint (single-component)
- ✓ Stain blocking paint
- ✓ Textured paint
- ✓ Block fillers and sealers
- ✓ Wood, masonry, driveway sealers and water repellants (non-tar based or bitumen based)
- ✓ Paint aerosols of all types including automotive, craft and industrial products
- ✓ Already empty paint containers

\*Unless registered under Pest Control Products Act.

### Paint Products Not Accepted

- ✗ Industrial paint and finishes
- ✗ Paints or wood preservatives that are registered as a pesticide under the Pest Control Products Act (has a P.C.P Registration number on the label)
- ✗ Non-Aerosol craft paint
- ✗ Non-Aerosol automotive paint
- ✗ Two-part or component paints containing a catalyst or activator
- ✗ Roofing products (i.e. patch, tar or repair)
- ✗ Tar or tar/bitumen-based products
- ✗ Traffic or line marking paint
- ✗ Resins, fibre-glass
- ✗ Paint thinner, mineral spirits or solvents
- ✗ Deck cleaners
- ✗ Colourants and tints
- ✗ Caulking compound, epoxies, glues or adhesives
- ✗ Other household chemicals
- ✗ Nitro-cellulose based paints



## Toxics

Products that display the poison symbol, the word "Danger" and are a liquid or aerosol. Maximum container size is 10 litres and 680 grams or 24 ounces for aerosols.

- ✓ Furniture stripper
- ✓ Automotive additives
- ✓ Lubricants
- ✓ Tar and bug remover
- ✓ Kerosene
- ✓ Mineral Spirits
- ✓ Paint thinners (e.g. Varsol)

## HHW Products Not Accepted

- × Commercial, industrial or agricultural products
- × Lead acid batteries
- × Oil / antifreeze
- × Mercury switches
- × Fertilizer, Plant Food
- × Wine and distilled spirits
- × Refillable propane cylinders
- × Ammunition
- × Drugs and medicines
- × Caulking compound
- × Diesel
- × Medical sharps
- × Insect repellents, disinfectants and pet products
- × Cosmetics
- × Powder forms (solid) of masonry products, cement, grout, mortar, plaster of Paris
- × Products with a WHMIS or GHS label (symbol contained in red diamond)
- × Products under the flammables and corrosive categories that are intended for "**down the drain**" use during its primary intended use, such as bleach and drain cleaners.
- × Flammable liquids, corrosives or toxics sold in containers greater than 10 litres or greater than 680 grams/24 ounces for aerosols
